I have two blisters too!

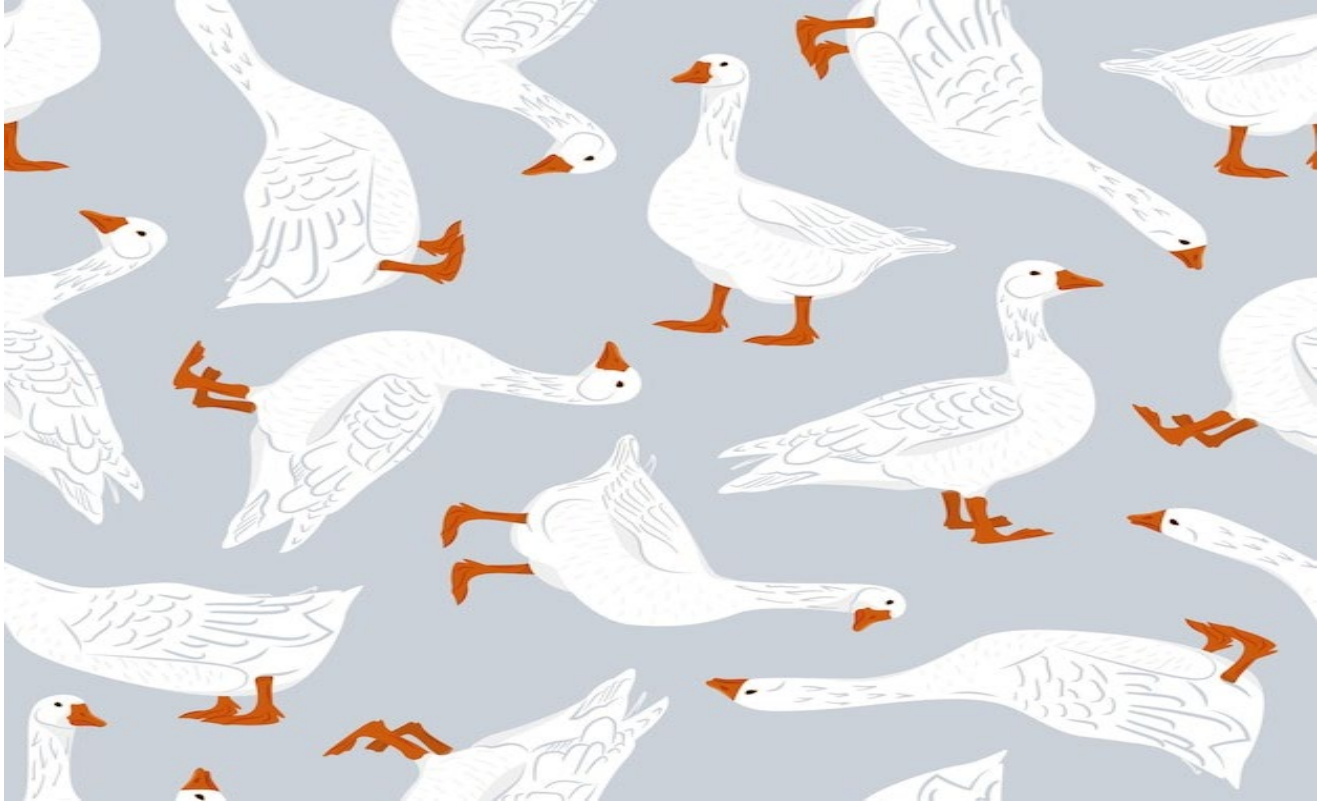

Here's two band aids from Gerdes for a friend!



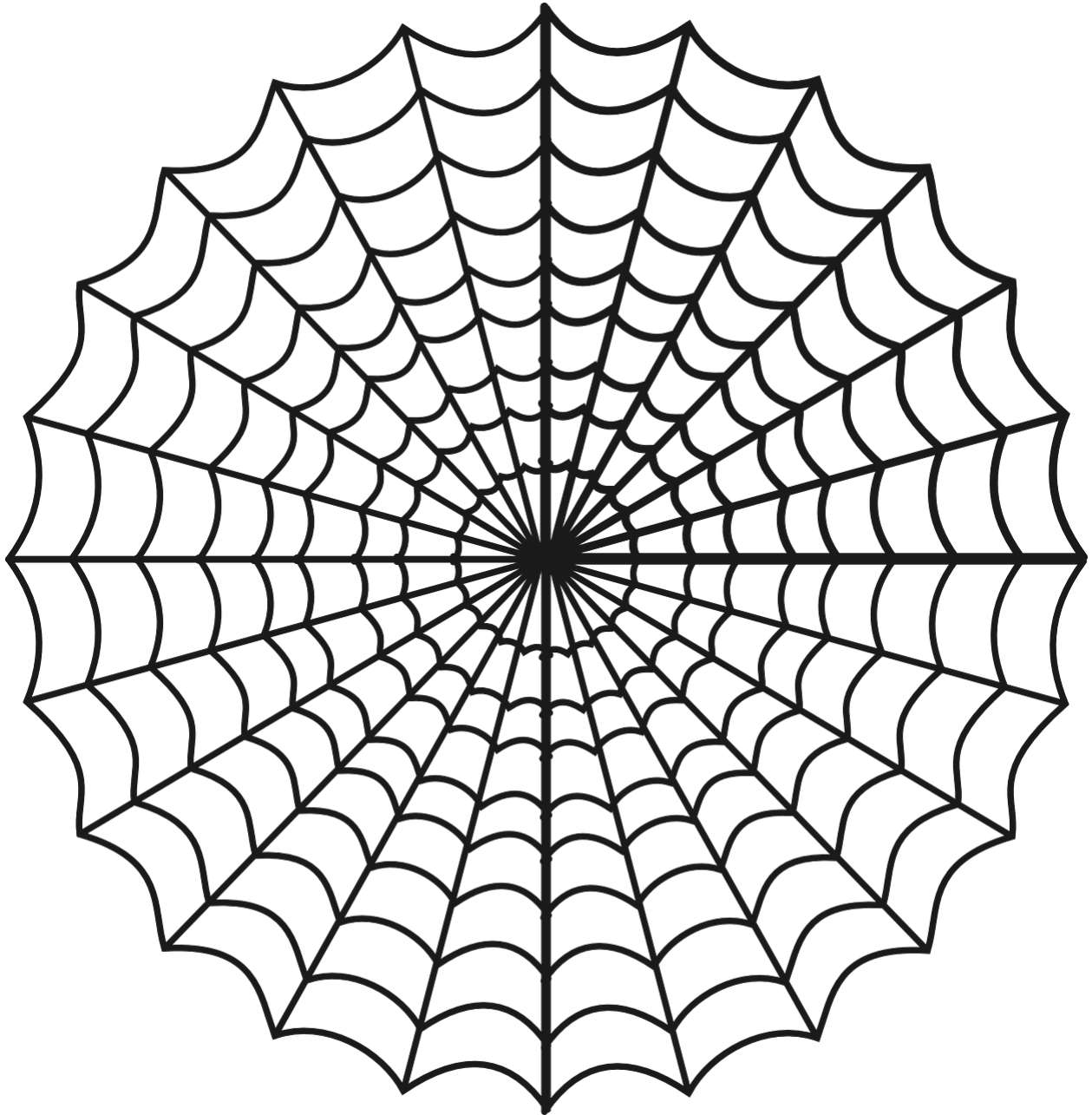
Grumpy Geese

(To the tune of The Farmer in the Dell)



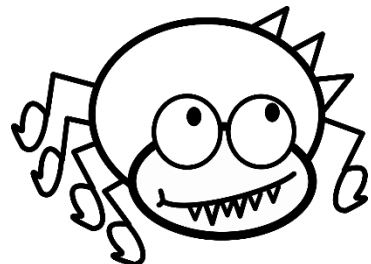
Geese grazing on the lawn,

Sneaky Spider

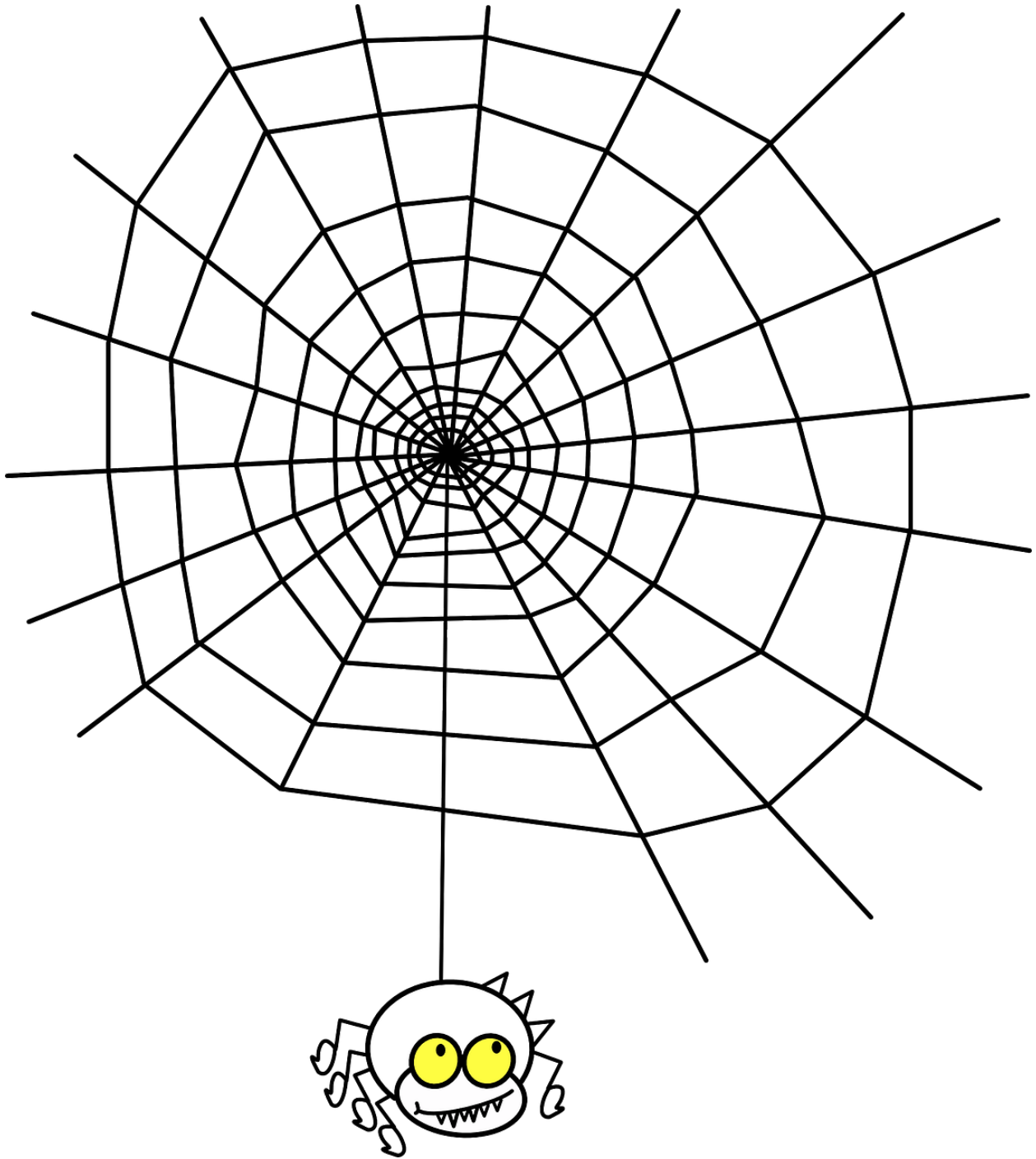


(To the tune of Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star)

(To the Tune of Mary Had A Little Lamb)

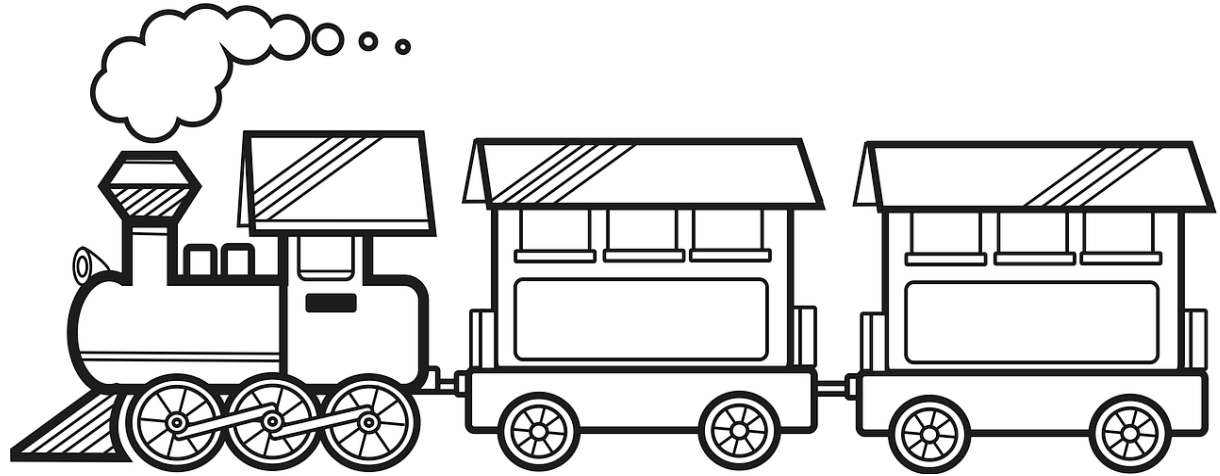

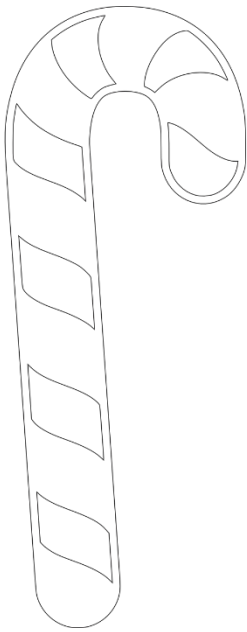

Sadly I climbed into bed.

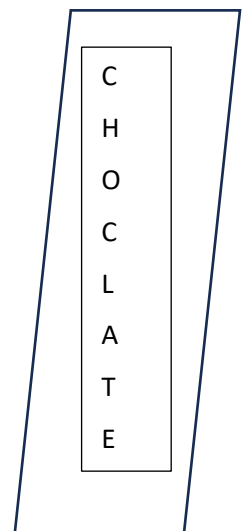
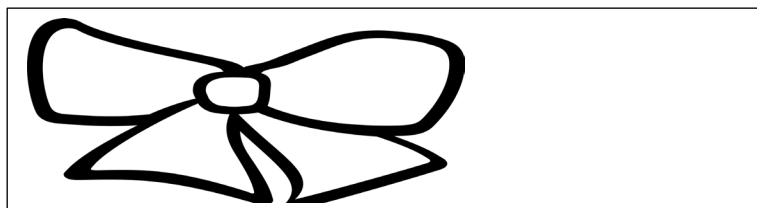
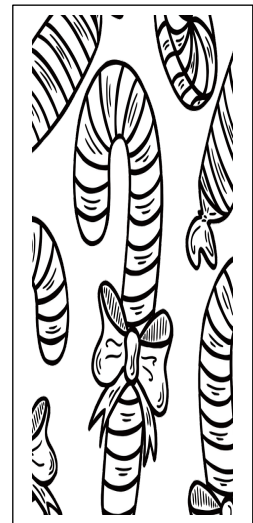
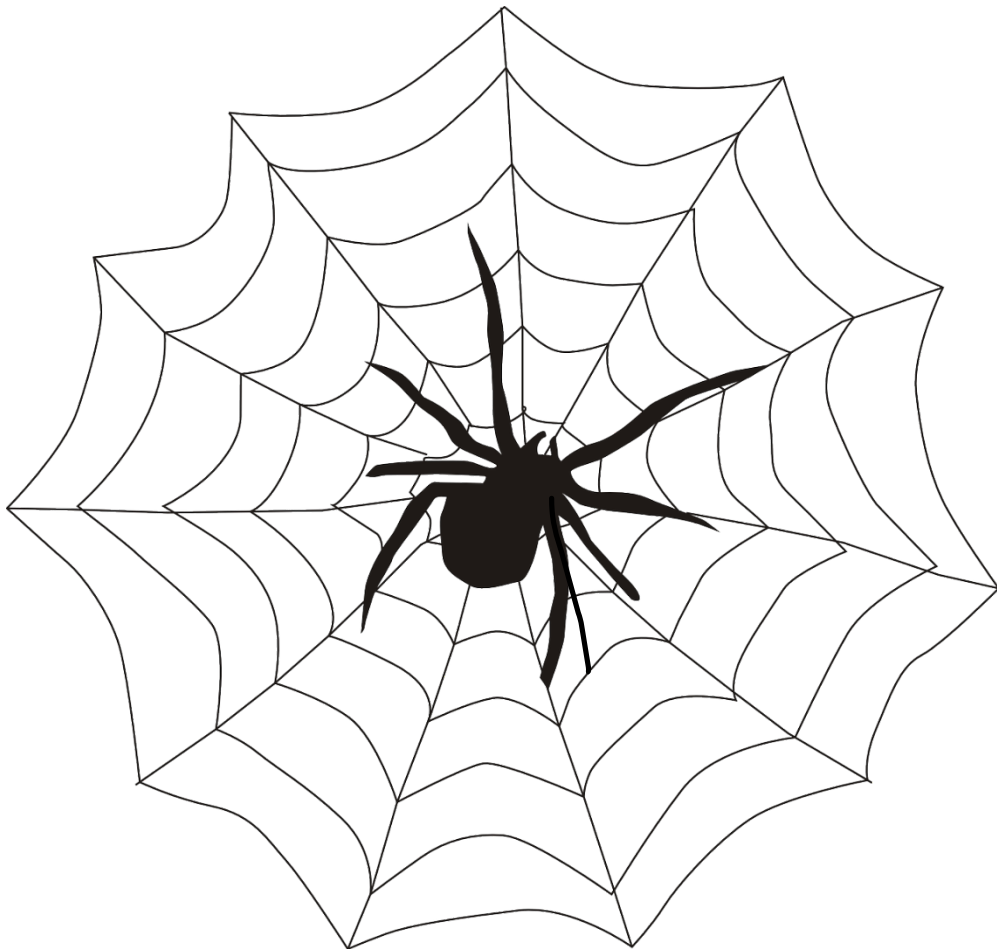
My Mom came to visit me the next day
